The video should include an excerpt of music from two different pieces of music with varying musical styles. The excerpts may be something that are performed in your school ensemble, studied in your private lesson, or an original composition that you have written. Your recording may be accompanied or unaccompanied. Before playing your selections, identify yourself, the name of your musical selections, and, in 30 seconds or less, tell us why you are interested in this camp.

Instrumental students need to have at least one year of experience playing their instrument. This experience can include private lessons, school ensembles, community, and church groups, etc. Students do not need prior skills in jazz techniques.
